

# Statewide Funding Opportunities

## PPE Marketplace

**Funder:** State of Indiana

**Provides:** Bundles of free masks, hand sanitizer and face shields

**Deadline:** No specific deadline, quantities may be limited based on demand

**Requirements:** Business or nonprofit registered with the Indiana Secretary of State, fewer than 150 employees

**Use:** Personal protective equipment (PPE) for use in operating your program.

**Application process:** Visit

## Indiana CARES About Child Care

**Funder:** CARES Act funds, administered by Indiana's Child Care Resource and Referral Network

**Amount:** Varies based on your program's total capacity

**Deadline:** Awards granted every two weeks, until funding is no longer available

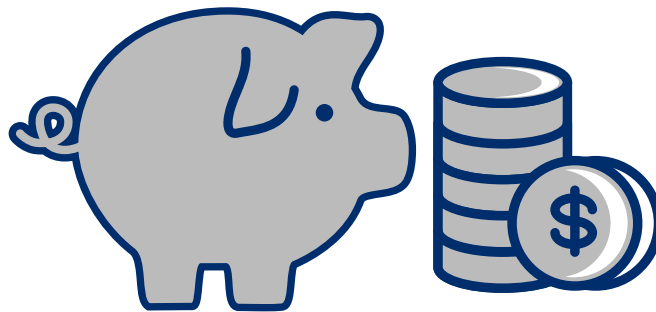
**Requirements:**

- Have children ages 0-12 in attendance OR have served children during August 2020 if currently temporarily closed
- Be an approved CCDF provider
- Operate a licensed center, family child care home, unlicensed registered ministry or legally licensed-exempt program (LLEP) that is not a school or Head Start/Early Head Start grantee in the state of Indiana, and is in good standing with licensing

**Use:**

- COVID-19 related needs, such as purchasing health- and safety-related materials and supplies, staffing, cleaning services and additional furniture to support social distancing
- Emergency funds to cover reopening expenses for providers who have temporarily closed due to a case of COVID-19

## Small Business Restart Fund

**Funder:** CARES Act federal funding via the state of Indiana

**Amount:** \$2,500 or \$5,000 for each month of 40% or more of revenue lost, with a maximum total of \$10,000 paid as a reimbursement for expenses (see use below)

**Deadline:** Check application site

**Requirements:**

- Registered to operate as a business in the state of Indiana
- Less than 50 employees on 12/31/2019
- Less than \$5 million in revenue in 2019
- Profitable in 2019
- Monthly revenue loss of at least 40% compared to pre-COVID-19 revenue
- Program did NOT receive funding from Paycheck Protection Program (PPP), Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) or Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

**Use:** Reimbursement for up to 80% of qualified expenses, such as rent/mortgage payments, utilities, lease payments for real or personal property and safety investments such as personal protective equipment (PPE) and infrastructure improvements

**Application process:** Visit

## Child Care Closure Assistance Grant

**Funder:** Office of Early Childhood and Out of School Learning (OECOSL)

**Amount:** Varies based on the number of self, private or cash pay children you serve, with a maximum of \$20,000

**Deadline:**

New grant cycle every two weeks, while funding is available

**Requirements:**

- Providers must have been temporarily closed because of a confirmed COVID-19 case of a person affiliated with the facility
- Providers must be eligible to receive CCDF

**Use:** Covers the cost of lost revenue during closure

from children who are funded through private pay/cash pay.

**Application process:** Visit
